

2.5.3 Running Osprey on Mac OS X (versions 10.2 or Higher)

After you have installed Osprey onto your Mac OS X, you can run the program one of two ways:

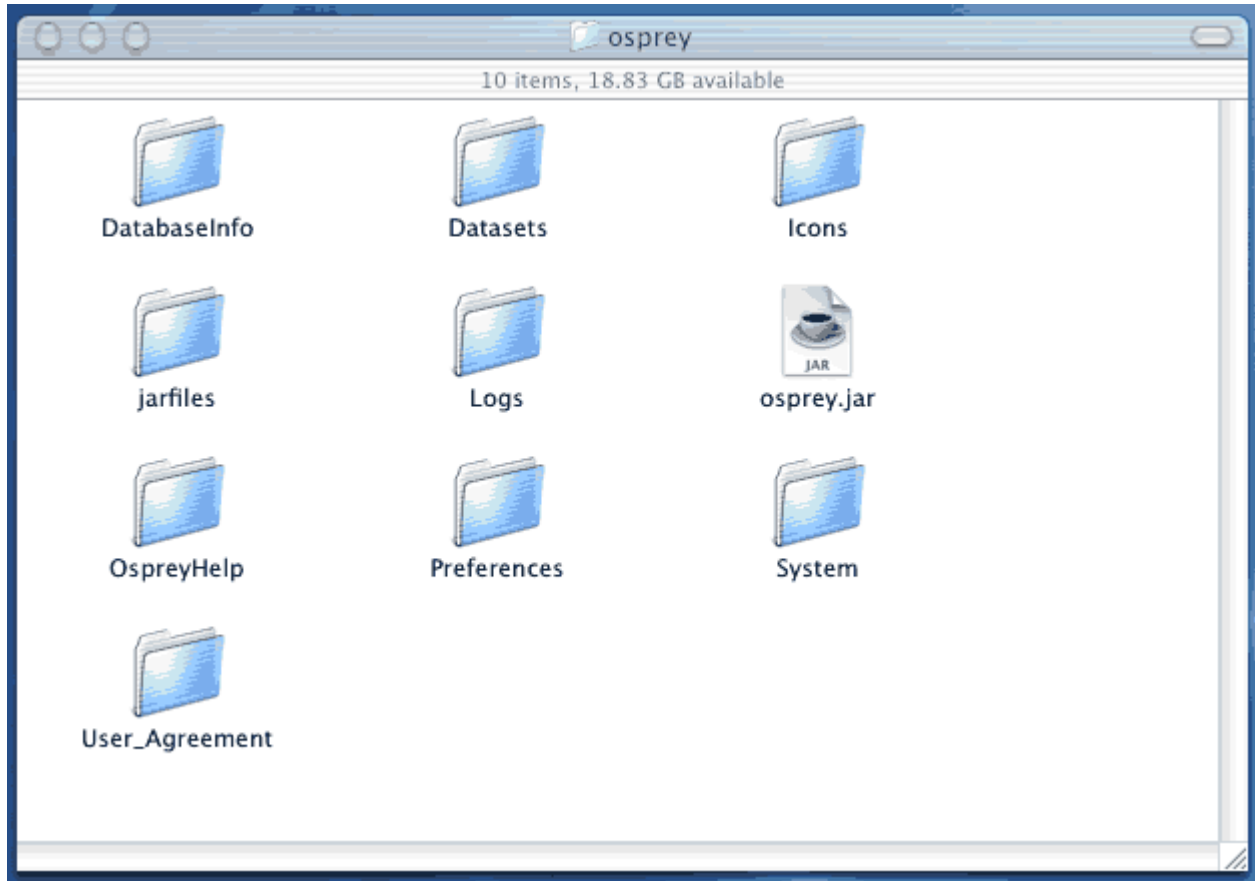


Figure 2.5.3-1: Default Osprey Location

1.) By executing the "osprey.jar" file located where the Osprey program was installed, by default this would be located on the disk inside "osprey_1.0.0" in the folder "Applications", see figure 2.5.3-1.

2.) If you created an alias for Osprey then you can execute the alias to the file "Osprey 1.0.0.jar", by default this should have been placed on the desktop, see figure 2.5.3-2.
